There is no need to come up with a fancy headline for your submission - a simple name and date will suffice.

Try to give your article an interesting intro. What makes your story unusual? What is the message you are trying to get across? Have you been toasting a success? Celebrating a milestone? Has one of your members done something spectacular? A snappy intro is more likely to engage readers, so don't make it too long and involved – you have plenty more paragraphs in which to expand and explain. If in doubt, email the editor, who is happy to offer advice and guidance to contributors.

Wouldn't it be great if every club submitted something for Voice Box? It's certainly something to aspire to!
